Spare Part Packages	Description
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Package 1: Consumables ▪ Package 2: Mandatory parts 	<p>Essential parts</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Package contains essential parts necessary to operate the machine in the first year. ▪ Package contains essential parts that can cause the entire machine to fail if they become defective. ▪ Safety relevant parts. ▪ The reordering period of the part is directly linked to the downtime of the machine. ▪ Strongly recommended to be kept in stock on site.
<p>Package 2: Critical parts</p>	<p>Increased uptime</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Parts that greatly limit the functionality of the machine if they fail or become defective. ▪ The machine may continue to be operated for a short period. ▪ Recommended to be kept in stock on site.
<p>Package 3: Non-Critical parts</p>	<p>Maximized uptime</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Parts that limit the functionality of the machine if they fail or become defective. ▪ Recommended for customers who highly depend on maximized uptime. ▪ Recommended for remote plants with difficult logistic and customs conditions.
